



Meeting minutes from Monthly Meeting held at Cascade Park on 8/19/25

Minutes: July minutes were approved.

Refunds/Credits: Nothing new was shared.

Budget/Balance:@ \$62,000- Registration, golf, crab monies are coming in and we have not paid anything out.

Registration Fees: Fees are coming in. Better than they have in the past. Registration must be completed as this is an insurance piece. (Jen and Jeff's teams are complete) Reminder that sponsorship money goes directly towards the players registration cost.

Try Outs: Tryouts went well. It was the largest tryout we have had in a long time. There are teams that still need players. If you are putting this out on Social Media, send to the board prior for approval.

Fall Ball: Nothing new was shared.

Advertising/Website/Social Media: Things look good on the website. Mike gave changes to Lisa. Teams may have social media accounts however a board member must be listed as an admin. Remind players about appropriate vs inappropriate posts especially while in Hot Shots attire.

Flyers must have all of the Recs and Parks info and need to be approved by Lisa, Jen, Mike or Drea prior to going out.
