Meeting minutes from Monthly Meeting held at NC Senior Center 10/21/19

Attendance record kept by the secretary

Mike started the meeting sharing flyers that were used for past events

Mike passed out insurance forms for those who said they needed them

Golf Tournament: Lisa shared that we profited \$3094.20

Lisa shared that there are some changes that she would like to make for the next tournament. She asked about getting a credit card reader for events such as the bingo, and other fundraisers. Drea shared that although we almost doubled the golfers, more money was spent on better prizes and golf balls therefore the profits were not as high. It was agreed to increase the price of next years tournament to \$90. This will help to offset the expense of nicer prizes. The cost of the food was questioned and we agreed that if we are going to increase the cost we should leave the meal as is. A request for Gatorade was made as well.

Bingo: Drea shared that she needs a preliminary head count as soon as possible. That it can be emailed to her. Each team is required to supply a theme filled basket/bag for the raffle. All ticket stubs, money and raffle items are to be to Drea no later than Nov. 10.

-Vince has agreed to sell the pull tabs, Tammy will pick up Chick Fil A, Mike will pick up Genova's.

Tournament at the Sports Complex: It was a good tournament with lots of teams. Hot Shots were well represented. We are hoping to clear \$500. Mike is looking at making changes for next year, possibly selling t-shirts. In the future the complex is looking to discount our fee. The complex will continue to run the concessions.

Forms: Jen and Lisa are to review the forms to make sure that the Park & Recs and ADA info is on all of them.

Advertising: Lisa can advertise on the sites for all teams. Send the blurbs to Mike first and he will review them prior to sending them to Lisa for publication.

-Jonathon is going to be putting the signs out. Do not put any in Reisterstown. We can hit Finksburg area hard as they only have 2 teams. Mike has spoke to them about joining us. If they do our coaches cannot approach their players until after the spring season.

Uniform designs were looked at by the team representatives. A decision was agreed upon in regards to the design.
